III. Guideline for data validation and usage

- (1) Women's Marriage, Fertility and Employment Survey, 2006 is the collateral project investigation of Manpower Survey, 2006.
- (2) Starting from June 2008, no longer has DGBAS released the information regarding the corresponding codes to the real names of regions, including county/township/city/district as well as village. CSR recodes the original codes into four new sets: the years of (1)1978-1982, (2)1983-1989, (3)1990, and (4)1991 and later, respectively. The code of the same set, despite the year of investigation, represents its identically corresponding region (town).
- (3) In view of sample representativeness and data consistency, parts of subgroups with a small number of samples or recognizable characteristics are

not appropriate to employ the estimation of an individual county/city. Therefore, the number of each county/city should rely on the DGBAS's report.

- (4) In case of any inconsistency in value description between project report and dataset, priority is given to findings in dataset (and code book) after confirming with the DGBAS.
- (5) The column widths of variable label and value description in the STATA are limited to 80 and 40 bytes, respectively, so the STATA dataset shows only the first 80 bytes as variable label, and the first 40 bytes as value description. In case of cut-off contexts, please see code book.
- (6) CSR has checked wild codes and out-of-range values to validate and clean data. Our findings are shown as follows:

The value “00” of the variables from b2_1_1_1 to b2_1_1_4 denotes the unsure birth-month of their first four borns.

- (7) Please be attentive if “system missing” may not be listed in the variable value because of the design of skip question (N/A), missing/no response and so on.
