III. Guideline for data usage

1. Some of data file' s value labels are different from which of questionnaire. It should be complied with the data file.
2. Regarding Q.B7, it mentioned that skip to Section C after finishing variable name b7_a. But since it is different from the condition of Q.B5, so it should be complied with the condition of Q.B5.
3. The length limitation of variable label and value label in STATA program are 80byte (40 Chinese characters) and 40byte(20 Chinese characters).
4. Data cleaning is based on 'Illegal Value'. Regarding 'missing', only those variable names which prescribed as 'cannot-be-missed' will be listed out.The result after data cleaning:
