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## KMT and DPP Agree on Positive Outcomes of Mother Language Education

The survey research center in a well-known national university just published the latest report (2018) on the quality of mother language teaching at schools. The result shows that around 88% of parents are satisfied with the quality of mother language education. Additionally, compared to the last year (2017), the satisfaction rate in 2018 increases by 10 %. It is the highest rating in the recent five years. Such performance rating is acknowledged by legislators from both the ruling and opposition parties

The survey research center said that this big improvement could be attributed to the adoption of immersion mode of language teaching. According to the survey conducted by the survey research center, more than 96 % of parents are satisfied with the activity-- Day of Taiwanese language. This kind of activity could create a good learning environment. Parents could communicate with children using mother language, improving the effectiveness of mother language learning.

The Ministry of Education applauded the positive performance. Officials promise to devote more resources to polish the curriculum design and improve teacher education. They expect to make the timing of learning mother language much earlier and increase the number of language speakers.

But today, some legislators from the opposition parties in the legislative committee highly suspect the credibility of this performance information. They argue that this information is misleading. Hence, they acclaim to cut the budget for the mother language education next year. Some KMT legislators talking with our reporters said that the survey is not representative. There is a huge gap between the actual and reported level of satisfaction. Moreover, they criticize that the Ministry of Education often release performance information in a selective way. They only report the positive results but keep the negative results hidden. Therefore, this performance information papered over the cracks.
