III. Guideline for data validation and usage

1. CSR has checked wild codes and out-of-range values, to validate and clean data. There is no doubt about data accuracy after the validation.
2. The column widths of variable label and value description in the STATA are limited to 80 and 40 bytes, respectively, so the STATA dataset shows only the first 80 bytes as variable label, and the first 40 bytes as value description. In case of cut-off contexts, please see questionnaire (or code book).
3. Weighting:

The Telephone Interview data are weighted by raking method along with population distribution of sex, age, education, and area. The population parameters are referred to “2011 Demographic Fact Book, Republic of China”, published by Ministry of The Interior Republic of China. Internet survey data are not weighted to avoid bias because the dataset is relatively small.
