2. Note for data usage

- (1) The column widths of variable label and value description in the STATA are limited to 80 and 40 bytes, respectively, so the STATA dataset shows only the first 80 bytes as variable label, and the first 40 bytes as value description.
- (2) In case of any inconsistent findings between project report and dataset, priority is given to findings in dataset.
