III. Guideline for data validation and usage

- 1. Because some variable labels and some value labels can't acquire, they are not possible supplementary instructions.
- 2. In case of any inconsistent findings between dataset, questionnaire and frequencies, priority is given to findings in dataset.
- 3. The column widths of variable label and value description in the STATA are limited to 80 and 40 bytes, respectively, so the STATA dataset shows only the first 80 bytes as variable label, and the first 40 bytes as value description. In case of cut-off contexts, please see questionnaire.
- 4. Please be attentive if "system missing" may not be listed in the variable value

because of the design of skip question (N/A), missing/no response and so on.
